PUBLIC NOTICE (16 March 2020)

The **National Testing Agency (NTA)** has been established by Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) as an independent/autonomous, self-reliant and self-sustained premier testing organization. The conduct of the Joint CSIR- UGC NET Examination has been entrusted to the NTA by CSIR, Government of India. Only bonafide Indian Citizens are eligible for the test. CSIR-UGC NET Fellowship is tenable in India.

The NTA will conduct the next Joint CSIR-UGC NET for Junior Research Fellowship and eligibility for Lectureship (LS)/ Assistant Professor on 21 June 2020 for following subjects:

- 1. Life Sciences
- 2. Physical Sciences
- 3. Chemical Sciences
- 4. Earth, Atmospheric, Ocean and Planetary Sciences
- 5. Mathematical Sciences

The Test will be conducted in two different shifts as given below:

Shift	Timing	Duration
*Shift – 1 (Morning)	09:30 am to 12:30 pm (IST)	03 hours (180 Minutes)
*Shift – 2 (Afternoon)	02:30 pm to 05:30 pm (IST)	

^{*}Subject(s) in a shift will be decided based on number of students.

The Test will be conducted in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode only.
