Release of Admit Cards of Banaras Hindu University (BHU) Entrance Test - 2021

The National Testing Agency (NTA) will be conducting the Banaras Hindu University (BHU) Entrance Test – 2021 for admission to the Under-Graduate (UET) and Post-Graduate (PET) Programmes for the academic session 2021-22 throughout the country from 28 to 30 September & 01, 03 and 04 October 2021 through Computer Based Test (CBT)/ Hybrid (tablets)/ Pen and Paper mode (OMR based).

Recently, NTA has come to know from the student community that **some of the Test Papers of BHU Entrance Test-2021 are clashing with some major Examinations.** Accordingly, it has been **decided to reschedule the dates of following Test Papers** of Banaras Hindu University (BHU) Entrance Test – 2021:
