In Continuation of the Public Notice dated 02 September 2022, The National Testing Agency (NTA) is conducting the Common University Entrance Test[CUET (PG)-2022 in two shifts Shift 1: 10.00 A.M. to 12.00 P.M. and Shift 2: 03.00 P.M. to 5.00 P.M. through the Computer Based Test (CBT) across the country in about 500 centres.
