Declaration of results of the All India Sainik School Entrance Exam (AISSEE) -2022

The All India Sainik School Entrance Exam (AISSEE) 2022 was conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) on 09.01.2022 in the paper-pen mode at 360 centres, located in 167 Cities across India, for admission to Class VI and Class IX in the 33 Sainik Schools in the country.

Exam for Class VI was held in the following 13 languages: Assamese, Bengali, English, Gujarati, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odiya, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu and Urdu.

Exam for Class IX was held in English only.

The exam was held taking all necessary COVID-19 precautions, observing social distancing, sanitization of the exam centre, desks, chairs etc. staggered entry of candidates into the exam hall, provision of masks to candidates, etc.

166 City Co-ordinators and 356 Observers were appointed across the country to ensure smooth conduct of the exam.

Post exam, the questions, provisional answer keys, OMR answer sheets and the recorded responses of the candidates were hosted on the NTA website during 02-05 February 2022 and challenges were invited from the candidates who appeared in the exam.

Challenges received were verified by the experts and the results were processed as per the answer keys finalised by the experts.

Results of the exam were declared on 28.02.2022 and hosted on NTA's website https://aissee.nta.nic.in and https://ntaresults.nic.in
