## PUBLIC NOTICE (02 February, 2021)

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been established by Ministry of Education MoE (Earlier Ministry of Human Resource Development- MHRD) as an independent/ autonomous, self-reliant and self-sustained premier testing organization. It has been entrusted by UGC and Ministry of Education, Government of India with the responsibility of conducting the UGC-NET examination.

The NTA will conduct the next UGC-NET exam for Junior Research Fellowship and eligibility for Assistant Professor on **2**, **3**, **4**, **5**, **6**, **7**, **10**, **11**, **12**, **14** and **17** May 2021. The Test will comprise of two papers as given below:

The Test will be conducted in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode only.
