National Testing Agency will be conducting Common Management Admission Test (CMAT)-2026 in Computer Based Test (CBT) mode. As per the information published in Information Bulletin and Public Notice dated 17 October 2025 and 17 November 2025, wherein it is mentioned that correction facility would be provided for the Online Application Form of CMAT-2026.

- 3. All the registered candidates for the CMAT Examination are advised to visit the website (https://cmat.nta.nic.in/) and verify their particulars. It is also advised to make correction(s) in their particulars, if required. The window for corrections shall be available as per above schedule (up to 11:50 P.M.). After this deadline, no further corrections will be permitted under any circumstances.
- 4. Since, it is a one-time facility extended to the candidates to avoid any hardship, the candidates are informed to do the correction very carefully, as no further opportunity for correction will be given to the candidates.
- 5. It is important to note that the final correction will be applicable only after payment of any additional fees, if required. In case where changes affect the fee amount, candidates will be charged excess fee accordingly. Please note that excess payment made will not be refunded.
