**Subject: Correction in the particulars of the online Application Form of National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026 - reg.**

The National Testing Agency will conduct the National Common Entrance Test (NCET) 2026 for admission to 4-Year Integrated Teacher Education Programme (ITEP) in selected Central/State Universities/Institutions including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and Government Colleges for Academic Session 2026-27 on **17 April 2026**. Registration for the aforesaid examination is over now.

2. As per the information published in Information Bulletin and Public Notice, it has been decided to provide an opportunity to make corrections in the particulars of their respective Application Forms of NCET 2026, as per the following details:

3. All the registered candidates for the said Examination are advised to visit the website (<https://exams.nta.nic.in/ncet/>) and verify their particulars. They are further advised to make correction(s) in their particulars, in their respective Application Form, if required. Thereafter, no correction in particulars will be entertained by NTA under any circumstances. The additional fee (wherever applicable) shall be paid by the candidate concerned either through Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI.

4. Since it is a one-time facility extended to the candidates to avoid any hardship to them, the candidates are advised to do the correction very carefully, as no further opportunity for correction will be given to the candidates.

5. **The List of Central and State Universities/Institutions, including IITs, NITs, RIEs, and other Government Colleges, which have been approved by the NCTE to offer the ITEP programme has been increased from 223 to 284 and is updated on the website. The Candidates who have applied for the NCET 2026 and want to modify their choice of University/Institution/course can make the necessary modifications during the correction window.**

4.	Candidates shall be allowed to change examination Cities based on their Permanent and Present address (it is once again clarified that NTA is not bound to follow the choices given by the candidates:	i. Examination City Selection ii. Medium of the Examination
5.	Candidate shall be allowed to change <b>All</b> the fields:	i. Date of Birth ii. Gender iii. Category iv. Sub-category / PwBD / PwD (If not verified by UDID) v. Signature
6.	Candidates shall be allowed to add/edit the fields:	i. Subject / Test Paper ii. University / Programme / Course
7.	Candidates shall be allowed to change identity details (only for candidates who registered with identity other than Aadhaar):	i. Aadhaar details
