### Sub: Conduct of Admission Test for Diploma in Sports Coaching (2026–27) of Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports - Reg.

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has been entrusted by the Netaji Subhas National Institute of Sports (NSNIS) with the responsibility of conducting the Admission Test for the Diploma in Sports Coaching (2026–27) for admission to the 64<sup>th</sup> Batch for the academic session 2026–27.

*Candidates are required to apply online through the NSNIS portal only and are advised to carefully read the Prospectus for detailed information regarding eligibility, reservation, sports disciplines, and admission procedures.*

The Admission Test will be conducted by NTA in **Computer Based Test (CBT)** mode on **31 May 2026 (Sunday)**. The test will consist of Multiple-Choice Questions (MCQs) with a total of **40 questions**. Each question will carry 1 mark and there will be **no negative marking**. The question paper will be bilingual (**Hindi and English**) except for the Language part.

## Syllabus for Online Admission Test

Section	Syllabus
Specialized Sports Theory	Basic terminology, abbreviations, technical rules, specifications of play fields / courts / arena / equipment, and competition format
General Knowledge	Current affairs, sports awareness (national and international), awards, rural sports, and promotional schemes
Logical Reasoning and Coaching Aptitude	Numerical, relational, sequential, diagrammatic reasoning, problem-solving and analytical aptitude
Language and Communication	Grammar, comprehension, synonyms, antonyms (matric standard, English)
Basic Computer Knowledge	MS Office, Excel, computer and internet terminology

The examination will be conducted in multiple cities across Bharat including **Ahmedabad, Ambala, Bangalore, Bhopal, Chandigarh, Chennai, Coimbatore, Faridabad, Gurugram, Guwahati, Hyderabad, Imphal, Jaipur, Jammu, Jodhpur, Kochi, Kolkata, Kozhikode, Lucknow, Mumbai, Nagpur, New Delhi, Noida, Patna, Pune, Raipur, Thiruvananthapuram, Varanasi and Visakhapatnam**, as well as at international centres in **Nepal and Sri Lanka**. *Candidates may indicate their preference of exam city while applying; however, NSNIS reserves the right to allot any other city/centre due to administrative reasons*

After the conduct of the examination, NTA will display the Provisional Answer Keys and recorded responses, and candidates will be given an opportunity to challenge the same on payment of a non-refundable fee of **₹200/- per question** within the stipulated time. The result will be prepared based on the final answer keys and shared with NSNIS for further admission-related processes. *No request for re-evaluation or re-checking will be entertained.*
