## **1. Introduction and Background**

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is a premier, autonomous testing organisation under the Ministry of Education, Government of India, established to conduct entrance examinations for admission and fellowship in higher educational institutions. NTA conducts some of the largest and most high-stakes examinations in the country - including JEE (Main), NEET (UG), UGC-NET, CUET (UG and PG), CMAT, GPAT and several others - serving crores of candidates every year.

The academic credibility of every NTA examination rests on the quality, fairness and rigour of its question papers, which are developed through the contributions of distinguished Subject Matter Experts (SMEs) drawn from across the country. NTA invites Expressions of Interest from eligible academicians, scientists, researchers, professionals and educators for empanelment as Subject Matter Experts for a period of three (3) years, to support NTA's confidential academic work across the spectrum of its examinations.

## **2. Scope of Work**

Empanelled experts may be called upon to undertake one or more of the following confidential academic activities, depending on their area of expertise and NTA's operational requirements:

- Item / Question Setting - Authoring questions of specified format, difficulty level and curricular alignment for one or more NTA examinations.

- Item / Question Vetting - Critical review of items developed by other experts for content accuracy, curricular alignment, language clarity, difficulty calibration, distractor quality and fairness.
- Translation and Multilingual Equivalence - Translation of items into Hindi and other regional languages, ensuring conceptual and difficulty equivalence with the master version.
- Moderation - Final review and approval of question papers, including selection of items from the item bank, paper composition, sequencing, marks distribution and overall quality assurance.
- Item Bank Curation - Continuous augmentation and improvement of NTA's secure item banks - tagging, calibration, retirement of over-exposed items and refreshment.
- Subject Expert Committees - Participation in subject-level expert committees for syllabus review, examination scheme deliberations, and policy inputs.
- Answer Key Verification and Challenge Resolution - Reviewing candidate challenges to provisional answer keys and providing reasoned responses.
- Curriculum Mapping and Specifications - Aligning NTA examinations with the prescribed curricula and developing test specifications, blueprints and item-development guidelines.
- Pilot Studies and Research - Participating in pilot administrations, pre-tests, validation studies and research on examination quality.
- Accessibility and Fairness Reviews - Reviewing items for accessibility (for candidates with benchmark disabilities) and for fairness across gender, language medium and regional / socio-economic categories.

### **Important**

Empanelment as a Subject Matter Expert does not, by itself, guarantee any specific volume of assignments or any minimum honorarium. Assignments will be allocated by NTA based on operational requirements, area of expertise, demonstrated quality of work and availability of the expert, and on the principle of fair distribution.

## **3. Subject Domains for Empanelment**

Expressions of Interest (EoIs) are invited from eligible experts possessing demonstrated academic, research, teaching or professional expertise in one or more subject domains relevant to the examinations conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). Applicants are advised to apply only in those subject domain(s) in which they possess recognised expertise and adequate academic or professional experience.

The subject domains cover, inter alia, school education, higher education, professional education, vocational and technical disciplines, research and interdisciplinary areas relevant to NTA examinations. These include, but are not limited to, School Education Subjects; Languages and Literature; Humanities and Social Sciences; Commerce, Business and Management; Law and Governance; Physical, Mathematical, Biological, Earth and Environmental Sciences;

Biotechnology and Life Sciences; Engineering, Architecture and Technology; Medical, Dental, Pharmacy and Health Sciences; Agriculture, Forestry and Allied Sciences; Animal, Veterinary, Dairy and Fisheries Sciences; Food, Nutrition, Home Science and Community Sciences; Fine and Performing Arts; Indian Knowledge Systems; Library and Information Science; Journalism and Mass Communication; General Aptitude and Examination Components; and other emerging or interdisciplinary subject areas.

The **comprehensive list of subject domains and specialisations** for which applications are invited is provided in **Annexure-II (Comprehensive List of Subject Domains for Empanelment)**, which forms an integral part of this Expression of Interest. The list in the Annexure is illustrative of the current requirements of NTA and may be revised, expanded, merged, reclassified or updated by NTA from time to time to meet evolving academic, professional and examination requirements.

Applicants may apply for **up to three** subject domains in order of preference from those specified in Annexure-II. NTA reserves the right to determine the final subject domain(s), level(s) and nature of work for which an applicant is empanelled, having regard to the applicant's qualifications, experience, demonstrated expertise and the operational requirements of NTA.

## **4. Eligibility Criteria**

Applicants must meet ALL of the following criteria to be considered for empanelment:

### **4.1 Academic and Professional Qualifications**

- Master's degree (or equivalent) in the relevant subject domain with at least 60% marks (55% for SC / ST / OBC-NCL / EWS / PwBD applicants) or equivalent CGPA from a recognised university or institution of repute. For professional disciplines (Engineering, Medicine, Law, Pharmacy etc.), the equivalent professional qualification will be considered.
- Ph.D. in the relevant or allied discipline is preferred. For school-level subjects, a Master's degree with substantial teaching experience is acceptable.
- Minimum 8 years of post-qualification teaching, research or professional experience in the relevant subject domain. For school-level subjects, the experience can include senior secondary level teaching at a recognised school / institution.
- Currently or recently affiliated with a recognised institution - university, college, autonomous institution, research organisation, central / state Government department, or an institution of national importance. Recently retired faculty (within the last 5 years) are also eligible.

### **4.2 Demonstrated Expertise**

- Recognised expertise in the subject domain through one or more of the following: peer-reviewed publications, books or monographs, conference presentations, prior question-

paper-setting / vetting / moderation experience for recognised examination bodies (UGC, CBSE, university examinations, IIT JEE, NEET, etc.), curriculum development experience at university or board level, or recognition through awards / fellowships.

- For applicants applying for translation and multilingual work - demonstrated bilingual or multilingual proficiency, with evidence of past translation work in academic contexts.
- For school-level subjects - additional preference will be given to applicants with experience in NCERT, CBSE, KVS, JNV, NIOS, State Boards or other recognised school-level academic bodies.

### 4.3 Integrity and Independence Criteria

#### **Critical Eligibility Conditions**

Given the highly confidential and sensitive nature of NTA's work, the following integrity criteria are NON-NEGOTIABLE. Any applicant who does not meet, or does not commit to abide by, these criteria is ineligible for empanelment.

- The applicant must NOT be associated, directly or indirectly, in any capacity, with any candidate-coaching organisation, test-preparation company, exam-coaching institute, online or offline tutoring platform, or any private entity engaged in the business of preparing candidates for NTA examinations or similar entrance examinations. This includes ownership, partnership, employment, advisory roles, content authorship, faculty engagement, equity holding, royalty arrangements or any other commercial or non-commercial association.
- The applicant must not have authored, co-authored, contributed to, edited or endorsed any commercially-published preparation material, mock test, question bank or sample paper for NTA examinations or similar entrance examinations, in the last 5 years.
- The applicant must not have any active or recent commercial relationship with any candidate-facing test-preparation entity in the last 3 years.
- No immediate family member of the applicant (spouse, children, parents, siblings) should be appearing for any NTA examination in the years for which the applicant is empanelled. Any such situation arising during the empanelment period must be disclosed proactively, and the expert will be excused from work pertaining to that examination cycle.
- The applicant must not have any active criminal case, departmental enquiry, vigilance proceeding or pending disciplinary action.
- The applicant must not have been previously debarred, blacklisted or removed from any examination body for malpractice or breach of confidentiality.
- The applicant must agree to undergo a comprehensive background and integrity verification before empanelment.

### 5. Honorarium and Other Entitlements

Empanelled experts will be paid an honorarium and other entitlements as per NTA's standard rate structure for the relevant nature of work. The rate structure will be communicated separately to empanelled experts and will be revised periodically in line with Government norms.

### **5.1 Honorarium**

- Per-item honorarium for original question setting, calibrated to the difficulty and nature of the item.
- Per-item honorarium for vetting, translation and moderation, calibrated to the depth of review.
- Per-day honorarium for participation in expert committees, moderation meetings, and other on-site work at NTA.
- Specific honorarium structures for answer-key verification, item-bank calibration, curriculum mapping and other ad-hoc assignments.

### **5.2 Travel and Accommodation**

- For experts called to NTA Headquarters in New Delhi or to designated venues elsewhere, NTA will arrange or reimburse travel by the most economical means commensurate with the seniority of the expert (typically AC-II Tier rail or economy class air travel for designated levels).
- Accommodation arrangements during the assignment will be made by NTA at a guesthouse, hotel or designated facility, with appropriate dietary arrangements.
- Local transport from the place of stay to the assignment venue and back will be provided by NTA.
- Per-diem allowance during the period of stay at the assignment location, in line with NTA norms.

### **5.3 Tax and Statutory Deductions**

All payments will be subject to deduction of tax at source as per applicable provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961, and to other statutory deductions as may be applicable from time to time. Empanelled experts will be required to submit PAN, address and other documentation as required for compliant payment processing.

## **6. Confidentiality and Integrity Obligations**

### **Absolute Confidentiality - Mandatory**

The work entrusted to empanelled experts is of the most confidential nature. Any breach of confidentiality, intentional or otherwise, can compromise an entire examination, affect lakhs of candidates, and damage the public interest. Empanelled experts are therefore expected to maintain the highest standards of confidentiality, professional integrity and academic ethics.

Empanelled experts will be required to abide by the following confidentiality and integrity obligations:

- Sign a comprehensive Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) at the time of empanelment, and re-affirm it at the start of every assignment.
- Maintain absolute confidentiality regarding the assignment, the questions developed or reviewed, the source material accessed, and any other information acquired during NTA work, both during and after the empanelment period - in perpetuity.
- Conduct all confidential work strictly within the prescribed venue (typically NTA's Headquarters or a designated secure facility), or on the prescribed secure-platform if remote work is permitted; do not carry any confidential material outside the prescribed venue.
- Surrender all draft material, working notes, reference material, electronic files and other artefacts at the end of every assignment; retain no copies in any form.
- Use only NTA-provided devices, networks and platforms for all confidential work; do not use personal devices, personal email, personal cloud storage, USB drives or other external media.
- Do not photograph, screenshot, audio-record or video-record any confidential material under any circumstances.
- Do not discuss the assignment, the content, or any details with anyone outside the immediate group of co-experts working on the same assignment - including family members, colleagues, students, or any other person.
- Disclose proactively any actual, potential or perceived conflict of interest that arises during the empanelment period - including any new association with a candidate-coaching organisation, any change in family circumstances, or any other situation that could compromise the expert's independence.
- Refrain from any post-empanelment commercial association with candidate-coaching entities for a period of 2 years from the date of last assignment, in line with NTA's cool-off norms.
- Cooperate fully with any vigilance enquiry, audit or investigation that NTA may undertake.

#### **Legal Consequences of Breach**

Any breach of confidentiality, integrity or the terms of empanelment may result in immediate de-empanelment, recovery of honorarium paid, blacklisting from future engagements with NTA and other examination bodies, and prosecution under the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act 2024, the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita 2023, the Information Technology Act 2000, and other applicable laws.

## **7. Submission Requirements**

Applicants are required to submit the EoI through the NTA portal, with the following information and supporting documents:

## **7.1 Application Form**

The complete Application Form, as provided at Annexure-I of this document, duly filled and signed by the applicant.

## **7.2 Curriculum Vitae**

A detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV) covering: academic qualifications, professional career, current and past institutional affiliations, teaching and research experience, peer-reviewed publications, books, conference presentations, prior question-paper-setting / vetting / moderation experience, awards and fellowships, professional memberships, and any other relevant information.

## **7.3 Supporting Documents**

- Self-attested copies of all educational qualification certificates (Master's, Ph.D., professional qualifications)
- Self-attested copies of experience certificates / appointment letters covering current and past affiliations
- Latest Identity card from current institution (or pension order, for retired applicants)
- Copy of PAN card
- Copy of Aadhaar card (with optional Aadhaar number masking)
- Copy of one Government-issued photo ID (Passport / Voter ID / Driving Licence)
- Cancelled cheque of bank account for honorarium payments
- Recent passport-size photograph
- No Objection Certificate (NOC) from current employer (for serving employees), or undertaking that NOC will be furnished at the time of first assignment
- Conflict of Interest Declaration (as provided in Annexure-I, Section H)
- Self-Declaration of Confidentiality and Integrity (as provided in Annexure-I, Section I)

## **8. Evaluation Process**

Submitted Eols will be evaluated by NTA in the following stages:

### **Stage 1 - Documentary and Eligibility Verification**

NTA will examine the completeness of the application, the applicant's qualifications and experience against the eligibility criteria, and the supporting documents. Applicants who do not meet the minimum eligibility criteria, or who have not completed the integrity declarations, will not be progressed.

### **Stage 2 - Subject-Matter Evaluation**

Eols that pass Stage 1 will be evaluated against subject-domain criteria - including academic standing, research record, prior question-paper experience and depth of expertise. The evaluation will be conducted by Subject Expert Committees constituted by NTA.

### **Stage 3 - Background and Integrity Verification**

Shortlisted applicants will be subject to comprehensive background verification - covering academic credentials, employment history, integrity declarations, conflict-of-interest disclosures and any other checks NTA may consider necessary.

### **Stage 4 - Empanelment**

Selected applicants will be communicated their empanelment in writing, with the subject domain(s), level(s) and nature of work for which they have been empanelled. Empanelment will be for a period of three (3) years from the date of empanelment, subject to satisfactory performance and continued integrity. Empanelment may be terminated earlier in case of breach of any term, on reasonable grounds, with appropriate notice.

## **9. General Conditions**

- Empanelment is purely on a contractual / engagement basis and does not confer any right of regular appointment, employment or absorption with NTA.
- Empanelled experts will not represent themselves as employees, officers or representatives of NTA, or use any NTA branding, logo, or designation in any external communication or publication, without explicit written permission.
- Empanelled experts will not author, co-author, contribute to or endorse any preparation material, mock paper or coaching content for NTA or similar examinations during the empanelment period and for 2 years thereafter.
- Empanelled experts will not engage with the media or public on any matter related to NTA examinations - including content, methodology, results or controversies - without explicit prior written permission from NTA.
- NTA reserves the right to allocate or not allocate work to an empanelled expert based on operational requirements, performance and other relevant considerations.
- NTA reserves the right to revise the rate structure, terms of empanelment, scope of work and other parameters from time to time, with reasonable notice to empanelled experts.
- Disputes, if any, arising in relation to this EoI or any subsequent engagement shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts at Delhi.
- Mere submission of an EoI does not entitle an applicant to empanelment. NTA reserves the right to accept or reject any EoI, to invite additional information, to conduct interviews, or to cancel the empanelment process at any stage without assigning any reason.
